

PVAAS for Administrators:

How do you have a conversation with a teacher who receives a RED on his/her PVAAS report? How about a GREEN or BLUE? And, what about conversations with new teachers, or veteran teachers?

Session Focus: Administrators will focus on how PVAAS growth and projection data can be incorporated into processes used in **planning** for conversations with teachers, **holding** conversations with teachers, and **following up** with teachers to guide them in using various PVAAS reports to plan for their students this year. (This session will not focus on the PVAAS methodology.)

Participants will learn how to:

- Use PVAAS and talk about PVAAS with teachers, including teacher specific reporting
- Determine if there are school level strengths and needs and/or teacher specific strengths and needs
- Use PVAAS growth data with teachers for annual data meetings/grade level meetings
- Connect Observation/Evidence data and PVAAS reporting
- Use student projection data with teachers for the students they have in the new school year



Each participant should bring

- A laptop or tablet with internet access
- PVAAS username, password, and PPID to access reporting
