- 4. Substitute teachers & technology
 - a) Flexibility in where teachers are providing instruction, especially when they might not be currently ill
 - (1) Sub in classroom, but teacher may be instructing from home while in quarantine
 - For day to day, subs asking students to project LMS (Schoology, Canvas, Google Classroom, etc.) to assist.
 - c) Creating general sub accounts (sub 1, sub 2, sub 3, etc.) to be assigned to subs, as needed.
 - (1) Weekly grid/format or Clever has helped in making sure students have correct links, etc.
