



## GRANT-FUNDED GYNECOLOGICAL SERVICES AVAILABLE

The Lehigh Valley Health Network & the team of specialists under Dr. Andrea Waxman's office have been participating in grant-funded gynecology services. The services are for adolescents up to age 21. The focus is on consumers with special needs. This includes individuals with autism, cerebral palsy, intellectual disabilities, vision impairments, and those who are deaf.

### Comprehensive services & continuity of care include:

- Gynecological services by Andrea Waxman, MD FACOG
- Nursing & Social Work Services
- Assistance with Contraceptive Management
- Management of Menstrual Disorders
- Continuing Services into Adulthood

This grant was provided by the Anderson Trust. The program began operating on Oct 1, 2012. Services are currently offered on Tuesday afternoons. Longer than average appointments are available. The office is handicapped accessible. It is located at 400 N. 17th Street, Suite 200 in Allentown. Please call Amy at 610-398-7848 to see if you qualify for an appointment. The office would like to expand its outreach and services to young women with disabilities who need gynecological care.
