

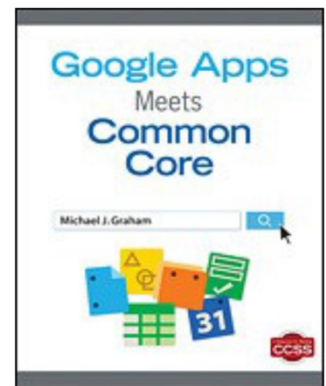
NEW TITLES IN THE ARC'S LIBRARY
