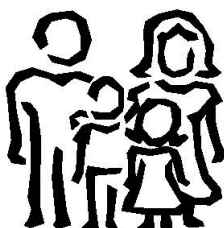
The PA ODP is pleased to offer a course in medication administration at home for Individuals and Families, Lifesharers, Providers of licensed and unlicensed Family Living, people living in family homes, advocates, and other interested parties.

Giving Medication at Home provides two (2) credit hours of professional development for Lifesharers who complete the course through the Provider Information Center (PIC). These two credit hours can be used toward the annual training requirements for family living. This course does not meet the licensing requirement for the Department of Public Welfare approved Medication Course for applicable licensed settings.

Providers In order to receive a Certificate of Achievement for this course, Family Living Provider staff must review all seven webcasts and the associated resources and complete a Training Confirmation.
