Pennsylvania's Autism Insurance Act (Act 62)

Act 62 requires some private health insurance companies to cover services to diagnose and treat autism for individuals up to age 21. This act has yet to be fully implemented. Medical Assistance (MA) would only be billed if the private insurance denies payment. If you are the caregiver for someone under age 21 on the autism spectrum, please check with your employer's human resources department to see if your insurance policy is covered by Act 62.
